This program provides opportunities for you to gain experience, build relationships, gain community service hours and have an excellent volunteer highlight for your college or employment resume...not to mention the possibility of earning up to a \$1000.00 scholarship.

As a Student Auxiliary KDB, Inc. member will participate in KDB, Inc. Board Meetings, volunteer and assist with events, represent KDB, Inc. at ceremonies, events or luncheons, participate with various other local committees/events on our behalf, assist with outdoor cleanup projects, and promote KDB, Inc. within the community. You may also be involved in outreach to schools or civic/volunteer groups. The level of commitment from you will also require weekend or evening work at times. You are required to complete a minimum of 20 hours to be eligible and considered for the scholarship.

Applicants to the Program should:

- Be a High School Junior or Senior enrolled in a Douglas County School
- Be at least 16 years of age at time of application
- Have the ability to commit to a minimum of 20 hours of service during the September – May. Many events occur on weekends/evenings and during the day.
- Represent KDB at ceremonies, events or other public functions
- Have the ability to interact with local businesses, politicians, volunteers, school and community leaders
- Have an interest in or prior experience in working on environmental projects (recycling/litter/beautification)
- Be able to assist with outdoor, manual work at times (cleanup events/flower planting)
- Promote a positive image in their community
- Show interest or experience in community, environmental and volunteer projects
- Organize, promote and lead a project or activity that encourages environmental stewardship within the school or community. Status reporting and project updates will be required.
