- No alcohol allowed*No tractors allowed*No semi-trucks allowed*No throwing of candy or objects from any type of entry. Candy will be allowed to be handed to participants, spectators of the parade.
- Must have rear-view mirrors on all towed or self-propelled floats. You must have a 36" railing on all floats and trailers to be able to carry riders. All float riders have to remain seated at all times.
- Stay at least 20-25 feet from the entry in front of you. No speeding. Drivers of any type of entry may not leave vehicle, float. Operate all vehicles, floats in a safe manner. No careless maneuvering of vehicle/floats.
- No jumping on floats, no standing on floats, and all floats must have adult spotters with children riders. Spotters must walk alongside of designated seating area of floats. Spotters are not allowed to hand-out candy or objects.
- All objects need to be attached to vehicles/floats. All occupants will remain seated inside truck beds. No riding on truck bed fender walls, top of truck cab, or on side of truck beds. No standing in truck beds. Flag etiquette will be observed at all times.
- Roll-back wreckers are allowed. You must have a 36" railing on roll-back wreckers if you have riders. You must have two adult spotters for roll-back wreckers with children riders.
- All large animals at end of parade unless you have diapers on your animals.
- This is a rain or shine event.

Waiver & Release: All parade entry persons, businesses and organizations hereby agrees to indemnify & hold harmless the City of Douglasville, its' employees, contractors and volunteers from personal injury or property damage occurring to the entry and any personal injury or property damage to any third person or entity arising out of directly or indirectly by the participation in the parade. The parade entry assumes all risks and liabilities for its members and groups.
